

The NCFE Level 2 Certificate in Video Production

What's it all about?

The NCFE Level 2 Certificate in Video Production is an ideal qualification for those people would like to gain employment in the moving image industry.

What do I need to know before taking the certificate in Video Production?

You do not need to have studied this area before starting this course. It is important that you are energetic, creative, have a lively and enquiring mind, a real interest in video and moving images, a willingness to explore new ideas and an ability to communicate your ideas effectively. Good social skills and the ability to work as part of a team is also important. A basic level of numeracy and literacy is also necessary to help with the assessment parts of the qualification.

What will I study?

The qualification consists of **five** mandatory units:

Unit 1	Understand applications of moving image technology
Unit 2	Plan a moving image sequence
Unit 3	Use a video camera
Unit 4	Create a finished moving image product
Unit 5	Prepare for employment in the moving image production industry

Candidates must successfully complete all **five** mandatory units to be awarded the NCFE level 2.

Why choose this course?

You will have the opportunity to,

- ✧ Gain and develop skills in producing moving images;
- ✧ Gain underpinning knowledge of moving image production and opportunities available within the sector;
- ✧ Gain skills which lead to increased employability;
- ✧ Make steps into further training including relevant NVQs and therefore increase the likelihood of gaining employment.

How will I be assessed?

Assessment is the way your knowledge, skill and understanding will be measured against the standards set in the qualification.

All students' written evidence, assignments, projects, letters written, photographs and drawings will be kept in their portfolio. Also in the portfolio students must keep a list (index) of other evidence such as videotapes, sound records, large posters etc.

Internal assessment: This is the assessment that takes place within the college by your tutors (assessors).

External assessment: All credits awarded by the assessors (tutors) are subjected to external approval (verification). This is where someone from the exam board samples

student portfolios to make sure that the assessments fit in with their international standards. Credits can be adjusted at this stage where they are found to vary from international standards.
